Personal Gear Checklist

Please pack everything in one soft-sided pack or duffle bag. The largest duffle most airlines will accept as carry-on luggage is 22" x 14" x 9", about 35 liters in volume. If you want to bring a larger duffle, you may have to check a larger bag with the airline. Storage space on board is limited; please, **no hard-sided suitcases**.

Required

- A passport or the equivalent if we will be crossing the US / Canadian border.
- 2 pairs of long pants of a quick-dry material. Avoid cotton, including jeans.
- 3 long-sleeved shirts. Flannel is okay, wool or a quick-dry material is better.
- 1 undershirt of Merino wool or similar, for warmth and wicking.
- Fleece or other warm sweatshirt or sweater.
- 6 pairs underwear and socks. Wool or wool blend is better than cotton sox.
- 1 pair of running/boat shoes (Crocs are great) for wearing on board
- 1 pair of 15" high rubber boots. Xtratuf or Grunden's are excellent, but good less expensive alternatives online. Always pull-on, no laces.
- Waterproof rain gear - jacket with hood (or broad brimmed hat) and pants (Gore-Tex or similar material).
- Fleece vest, wool sweater, or similar. Down isn't great if it gets wet
- Pajamas or sweats-- whatever you sleep or lounge in.
- Sunglasses (polarized recommended for seeing below the water's surface).
- Toiletries (we provide soap and shampoo if you like and any medications you require.
- Non-drowsy Dramamine or similar, if you are prone to sea sickness.
- Passport, Enhanced Driver's License (EDL), or similar for border crossings.
- Gloves, fingerless or regular
- Beanie and or neck warmer

Optional

- Phone/tablet/laptop with chargers and cords.
- Headlamp or LED flashlight.

- A personal journal, sketchbook
- Noise-canceling headphones or earplugs (people snore).
- Alaska and/or Canada fishing license (available online).
- Adult beverages, soda, or juices.

Laundry

We do laundry once in the middle of the expedition for “essentials”. Laundry uses up a lot of our fresh water, so please limit your wash to the dirtiest. Mesh bags keep your items together in the wash.

Showers

Expedition members can shower every third day. Showers need to be short, but the water is hot.)
